KOKONUUCO'S INDIGENOUS CULTURE: LAND PROTECTOR

This area is home to the indigenous reservations of Coconuco, Purace and Paletara –part of Coconuco's ethnic group.

The Purace National Natural Park, declared a Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO in 1979, is a volcanic area. This is reflected both in its numerous sulfur springs and in its name which, in the Quechua language, means "mountain of fire".

The main rivers of Colombia –the Magdalena, Cauca, Patia and Caqueta rivers– originate there, as do 30 clear and tranquil lakes that are ideal for contemplation.

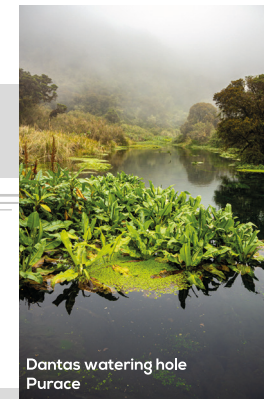
Part of Coconuco's landscape is the Coconuco volcanic chain. Also known as Serrania de los Coconucos, this chain is made up of 11 volcanoes. Of these, the most outstanding are the Pan de Azucar, Purace (the only asset) and Coconuco.
